EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Consumer Affairs Commission (CAC) conducted its annual school textbook survey during the period July 29 to August 2, 2024. Data was obtained from all parishes where bookstores were identified. A sample of sixty-four (64) bookstores were visited, however data was obtained from 60 outlets: 20 in the Greater Kingston Metropolitan Area (GKMR)¹ and 40 in Rural Towns.

A total of 180 popular textbooks were surveyed, consisting of one hundred and four (104) secondary level, sixty-four (64) primary level and twelve (12) infant level textbooks covering nineteen (19) subject areas.

Data analysis involved the calculation of the average, maximum and minimum price for each textbook as well as availability. Point to point comparative analysis included 167 books common to the two survey periods (2023 and 2024).

Summary of Findings:

On average, the prices of school textbooks increased by **6.61%** overall. The average price increase in the GKMR was 6.98% and 7.18% among rural towns.

This year's islandwide average price increase is lower than the average increase² observed last year by 2.4 percentage points. Additionally, it is 2 percentage points lower than the average increase observed last year in the GKMR, and 0.84 percentage point lower than the average increase observed last year across Rural Towns.

Islandwide, most books (65% or 109) recorded price increases between 1% and 10%. This was followed by thirty-nine (23%) books which recorded price increases between 11% and 20%. Two (2) CSEC/CAPE books recorded price increases ranging from 21% to 30%. Average price reductions (between 1% and 10%) were observed in 8% of school textbooks, while one CSEC /CAPE text recorded an average price reduction of 17.33%. Moreover, the average price of two books (1%) remained relatively constant.

As it relates to availability, it was observed that on average, availability was low (**39%**), falling by 5 percentage points when compared to the average availability of texts surveyed islandwide (44%) in July 2023. Some bookstores, however, said

that some texts were being revised and would be available closer to the end of August 2024. Notwithstanding, on average, Infant level textbooks were widely available in over 77% of outlets surveyed. The average availability of Primary level texts was 46%, with most texts being available in less than half of the outlets surveyed islandwide. PEP books were an exception, as on average, they were readily available in over 51% of bookstores surveyed. At the Secondary level, Literature Novels were available in 44% of bookstores islandwide. However, Grades 7-9 and CSEC/CAPE books were available in 29% and 27% of bookstores surveyed respectively.

On average, there was a 41% difference between the highest and lowest price observed for textbooks islandwide, except for literature novels, where the average was 92%. This was due to differences in the cover (hard /soft), publishers and sources. Within the GKMR and among Rural Towns however, the average difference was 19% and 38% respectively, among all textbooks, except for literature novels, where the difference between the highest and lowest price was on average 46% and 84% respectively.

More bookstores have increased the use of technology such as WhatsApp messaging. Consumers were also directed to use social media and webpages for price enquiry and order placement; with the option to either collect the books at the store or have them delivered.

Parents and guardians are therefore encouraged to use the online options available to them.



OVERVIEW OF TEXTBOOK SURVEY PERFORMANCE OF THE ECONOMY

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX AND INFLATION

The analysis of the Consumer Affairs Commission's (CAC's) Annual Textbook Survey must be interpreted, bearing in mind the trends in the local and global economy which impact the pricing and availability of these textbooks. Among these are the rate of inflation and the movement in the foreign exchange rate.

The latest data from the Statistical Institute of Jamaica on inflation indicate that the Point-to-Point inflation rate for the period of July 2023 - July 2024 was $5.1\%^3$.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE

Since the last survey in July 2023, the Jamaican dollar has undergone fluctuations against its major counterparts⁴. It ultimately depreciated by 1.2% when compared to the US Dollar, moving from a monthly average rate of J\$155:41 US\$1.00 to J\$157.30: US\$1.00. Similarly, in comparison to the British Pound, the Jamaican Dollar depreciated in value by 0.9%, moving from a monthly average rate of J\$200.26: GBP £1.00 to J\$202.12: GBP £1.00. Conversely, the Jamaican Dollar appreciated by 0.5% against the Canadian Dollar moving from an average monthly rate of CAD\$117.52: CAD\$116.89.




FIGURE 1.MOVEMENT OF JA\$ AGAINST US\$ BETWEEN JULY 2023 AND JULY 2024






FIGURE 3. MOVEMENT OF JA\$ AGAINST CAD BETWEEN JULY 2023 AND JULY 2024

SURVEY: BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The annual textbook survey was conducted by the Consumer Affairs Commission (CAC) between July 29 and August 2, 2024. The survey is geared towards providing consumers with information that will assist them to costeffectively discharge their responsibilities as parents/guardians; and presents researched evidence concerning textbooks as critical consumer items to key stakeholders.

Of the 64 known bookstores visited, price and availability data were obtained from 60⁵ bookstores (97%) islandwide. Data was collected from 20 stores in the Greater Kingston Metropolitan Area (Kingston, St. Andrew, Portmore and Spanish Town) and 40 bookstores in Rural Towns across 12 parishes. A total of 180 popular textbooks were surveyed, consisting of one hundred and four (104) secondary level, sixty-four (64) primary level and twelve (12) infant level textbooks covering nineteen (19) subject areas.

METHODOLOGY

Book Selection:

In keeping with the implementation of the National Standards Curriculum (NSC), the Ministry of Education and Youth's (MoEY) policy directive stipulates that the MoEY Supplementary Education Resources List should comprise not more than twelve books for each grade level per subject.⁶ These guidelines are intended to minimize the number of books parents need to purchase for their children. The rubric is outlined in Table 1 below:

TABLE 1. MOEY'S SUGGESTIONS REGARDING THE TYPE OF BOOKS APPROVED FOR PURCHASE BY PARENTS

Grade Level	Types of Books
1-3	No more than five (5) supplementary titles should be selected. This should include a reader, text/workbook for Language Arts and Integrated Studies.
4-6	No more than six (6) supplementary titles: only workbooks for core subject areas such as Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies and Science.
7-9	No more than two additional books for each subject area.
10-11	Schools have the autonomy to select supplementary resources based on the subject areas and the individual needs of the students

The MoEY's guidelines further indicate that parents should expect to purchase resources termed as Additional Materials Required. These include items such as a geometry set, graph books, scrapbook, technical equipment and other materials that are specific to specialized areas such as Home Economics, Visual Arts and Industrial Education; and resources such as a Bible, Atlas, Dictionaries, The Students' Companion, New Junior English Revised and Illustrated First Aid in English.

In keeping with the MoEY's principle of school-based management, schools are required to select and submit for approval the supplementary educational resources they deem most suitable for their students. These books are to be selected from the 2024-2025 Supplementary Educational Resources List provided by the MoEY. The school's educational resources lists are submitted to the Evaluation & Utilization Section/Media Services Unit of the MoEY for

approval. Each year, the CAC relies on this Unit to provide information on the most popular titles on the educational resources lists submitted by schools islandwide, to update its survey instrument.

During the 2024 review exercise, with the guidance of the Evaluation & Utilization /Media Services Unit of the MoEY, the CAC added 5 primary textbooks and revised four (4) secondary and revised twelve (12) primary books which had new editions available. These changes resulted in an overall increase of 5 books (175 in 2023 to 180 in 2024) in the number of books surveyed. Once a draft survey instrument was designed, it was submitted to the MoEY's Evaluation & Utilization Section/Media Services Unit to ensure that the texts selected were in line with their guidelines. The remainder of the survey instrument was left mostly unchanged to facilitate comparative analysis.

The CAC's survey officers were provided with a list of the books along with their respective International Standard Book Number (ISBN)⁷ and specific information to facilitate the correct identification of the book being surveyed (that is, a picture of the book, names of authors and editions). The survey officers were also provided with a list of bookstores within a particular geographical area where they would collect the price data. Data was captured and submitted using SurveytoGo, a mobile data collection application. The CAC research staff reviewed the prices and confirmed selected book prices with retailers.

Bookstore Selection:

A sample of sixty-four (64) bookstores or 89% of 72 known bookstores were visited: 20 were in the Greater Kingston Metropolitan Area (GKMR)⁸ and 44 in Rural Towns islandwide. The criteria used to select the outlets was based on the likelihood of the bookstore to stock most of the popular books in the CAC's sample. Regarding the major book chains, over 50% of branches of Bryan's Bookstores Ltd, Sangster's Bookstores and Kingston Bookshop were included in the sample.

ANALYSIS

Data analysis involved the calculation of the average⁹, maximum and minimum price for each textbook as well as availability. Availability refers to the number of stores surveyed that had the textbook in stock at the time of the survey. Thus, the term 'readily available' signifies that the book was found in at least 50% of the bookstores surveyed.

For comparative analysis, 167 textbooks common to the two survey periods (2023 and 2024) were used. The analysis included common titles which had been revised as this represents one of the reasons for the changes in price and availability of textbooks at the time of the survey.

PUBLICATION FACTORS AND PRICE VARIATIONS

There are several factors which could account for price dispersion among outlets. Some of these factors originate with the publisher and could include:

- a) Book Design
 - ✓ Illustrative component (e.g., colour vs. black & white)
 - ✓ Method of binding (e.g., cased sewn vs. spiral bound)
 - ✓ Quality of paper
 - ✓ Type of cover (e.g., hardcover vs. paperback)
 - ✓ Number of pages
- b) Print Quantity
 - ✓ This determines unit production costs
- c) Print Centre
 - ✓ Some of the Print Centres are located in China, India and Singapore
 - ✓ They utilize more modern technologies and tend to be more economical.

d) Edition

✓ Reprint vs. new edition.

- e) Fluctuations in Exchange Rates overtime
 - This may be further complicated by dollar versus sterling sources.
- f) The retailer may also introduce
 - ✓ Variations in the cost of delivery
 - ✓ Bulk vs. special delivery
 - ✓ Variations in mark up✓ Membership/ loyalty
 - programmes.

LIMITATIONS

- Essentially, limitations in resources money, manpower and time meant that the number of texts to be surveyed needed to be representative yet at a manageable level. The CAC's methodology includes selecting the most popularly requested texts based on the MOEY's review of the educational resource lists submitted by the schools. Furthermore, the texts must fall within the guidelines of the MOEY. This means that certain popular additional texts may have been excluded from the sample, although they are not prohibited by the MOEY. The selection of CSEC/CAPE texts was limited, as schools do not have to submit these for review by the MOEY. With the guidance of the MOEY, the CAC carried forward most of the popular texts surveyed in previous years, with some amendments.
- Some popular titles were unavailable at the time of the survey as they were being revised, the books were out of stock or not sold by the outlet.
- Some novels were available from various publishers. In instances where multiple versions of the novel were present in the outlet, the CAC recorded the least expensive copy of the text.
- Some outlets sold used texts as well as new ones. For uniformity, only the price data of new books was reported and analysed.

DATA SUMMARY JULY 2024 TEXTBOOK PRICE OBSERVATIONS

Availability

The Annual School Textbook Survey was conducted at a time when most bookstores were expected to have received their new stock but would still have residual stock from previous years. Observations revealed that while the availability of secondary levels books was generally low, Infant Level and PEP texts were readily available in most outlets visited.

Overall, the average availability of all textbooks surveyed islandwide was 39%. The low availability levels of some popular titles were explained by some outlets reporting that they had not yet received their new stocks at the time of the survey. The CAC was also advised that the **Language Tree Jamaica** series were being revised and the new editions would not be available in some bookstores until mid-late August 2024. Copies were unavailable in bookstores surveyed in the rural areas, while two (2 or 10%) bookstores in Kingston and St. Andrew reportedly had copies of the Books 1-5 of the student books and workbooks available. Additionally, the CAC's survey captured price and availability data on the previous edition of **Encore Tricolore** and **Investigating Science for Jamaica** workbook series, but it was observed that a newer edition of both texts was available on the market, alongside the older edition captured in the CAC's survey.

Notwithstanding, on average, Infant level textbooks were widely available in over 77% of outlets surveyed islandwide. The average availability of Primary level texts was 46%, with most texts being available in less than half of the outlets surveyed islandwide. PEP books were an exception, as on average, they were readily available in over 51% of bookstores surveyed. At the Secondary level, Literature Novels were available in 44% of bookstores islandwide. However, Grades 7-9 and CSEC/CAPE books were available in 29% and 27% of bookstores surveyed respectively.

Eight (5 secondary level and 3 primary level) textbooks were not available in any of the 60 bookstores surveyed. See Table 2 below for details:

Prices

On average, there was a 41% difference between the highest and lowest price observed for textbooks islandwide, except for literature novels, where the average was 92%. This was due to differences in the cover (hard /soft), publishers and sources. 

PRICE AND AVAILABILITY MOVEMENT

Summary

An island wide 6.61% increase in average price of textbooks was observed against the background of a 5.1% point to point inflation rate between July 2023 and July 2024 and the 1.12% depreciation in the JMD to its US counterpart for the period July 2023 to July 2024.

It was also observed that textbooks surveyed among outlets located in the Greater Kingston Metropolitan Region recorded a similar average price increase of 6.98% and 7.18% among outlets located across rural towns islandwide.

It was observed that average availability fell by 5 percentage points when compared to the average availability of texts surveyed islandwide (44%) in July 2023. Similarly, average availability of texts in the GKMR and Rural towns fell by 4 percentage points and 3 percentage points respectively.

Comparative data was available for 167 books: 12 Infant, 57 Primary, 39 Grade 7-9, 41 CSEC /CAPE and 18 Literature novels. This analysis represents an accurate reflection/representation of data captured by our survey officers on textbook prices for various outlets located islandwide.

Average Availability Changes Observed (Islandwide)

Regardless of the geographical region examined, the overall availability of textbooks was generally lower in July 2024 compared to July 2023. It was however observed the availability of texts within some grade levels increased or remained constant. As seen in Table 4 below:

- The availability of Primary level texts islandwide fell by 6 percentage points, followed by the availability of Grade 7-9 and CSEC /CAPE texts, which fell by 5 percentage points.
- Within the GKMR however, while the availability of CSEC /CAPE texts fell by 27 percentage points, the availability of Infant Level texts remained constant at 85%, and the availability of Literature Novels increased by 1 percentage point.
- Across Rural Towns, while the availability of CSEC /CAPE texts fell by 15 percentage point, the availability of Primary Level texts remained increased by 2 percentage points.

Average Price Changes Observed (Islandwide)




FIGURE 4. AVERAGE PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN TEXTBOOK PRICES, 2023-2024 (BY REGION)

• As seen in Figure 4 above, this year's islandwide average price increase is lower than the average increase observed last year by 2.4 percentage points. Additionally, it is 2 percentage points lower than the average increase observed last year in the GKMR, and 0.84 percentage point lower than the average increase observed last year across Rural Towns.

- Most books (65% or 109) recorded price increases between 1% and 10%. This was followed by Thirty-nine (23%) books which recorded price increases between 11% and 20%.
- This was true across grade levels, revealing that the average price of most CSEC /CAPE (80%), Grade 7-9 (67%), Infant (67%), Literature Novels (61%) and Primary (53%) levels increased between 1% and 10%. (see Figure 4 below).
- There were two (2) CSEC/CAPE books that recorded price increases ranging from 21% to 30%.
- The highest average price change was 27% (J\$438.33), recorded by the OXFORD SCHOOL DICTIONARY (Fully Revised 2016, Pocket Size) by Oxford Dictionaries.
- It was noteworthy that the average price of two or 1% of texts (1 CSEC /CAPE and 1 Primary level) books remained relatively constant or recorded zero price change.
- Some average prices recorded reductions in their average price. Fourteen books (8%) recorded price declines ranging from 0.01% to 10%. These declines were seen in all other categories of books, except at the Infant level.
- One (2%) CSEC/CAPE book recorded a price decrease, ranging from 11% to 20%: METALWORK TECHNOLOGY (Metric Edition) by G.H. Thomas, the average price of which fell 17.33% or \$723.00 below the average price recorded in July 2023.




FIGURE 5. AVERAGE PERCENTAGE CHANGE BY GRADE LEVEL (ALL ISLAND)

- The major observations in the movement of textbook prices based on geographic location and grade levels are summarized in Figure 5 below:

- Average price increase of J\$155.19 (8.27%).
- The price change observed ranged from an increase of J\$19.33 (1.71%) to an increase of J\$197.30 (10.94%).

• Primary School texts

- Average price increase of J 175.75 (7.61%).
- The price change observed ranged from a reduction of J\$139.88 (7.60%) to an increase of J\$285.10 (16.23%).

• Grade 7-9 School texts

- Average price increase of J 122.27 (6.34%).
- The price change observed ranged from reduction of J\$955.00 (33.69%) to an increase of J\$425.33 (42.7%).

• CSEC/CAPE texts

- Average price increase of J\$214.66 (6.05%).
- The price change observed ranged from a reduction of J\$51.89 (2.63%) to an increase of J\$303.71 (20.31%).

• Literature Novels

- Average price increase of J\$205.55 (7.30%).
- The price change observed ranged from a reduction of J\$209.17 (6.93%) to an increase of J\$568.31 (23.14%).

CONCLUSION

Acquiring school textbooks remains an important feature of back-to-school preparation for most parents and guardians and continues to account for a large proportion of back-to-school budgets and spending. The CAC's annual school textbook survey revealed that many books were still not readily available at the time of the survey, due to the restocking delays arising from revision of some primary level texts as well as low demand for some CSEC /CAPE textbooks.

The prices observed showed that some outlets had stocks from last year and that the prices were less varied within the GKMR than they were across parish lines. Overall, infant level books cost on average J\$1,893.68, while the price of primary level texts ranged from J\$1,000 to J\$5,195 depending on grade and location of stores. Secondary texts for grades 7-9 cost an average of J\$2,644.72, while the average cost of CSEC/ CAPE texts was J\$4,269.30. Literature novels were available on average for J\$3,160.47 relative to publisher, the type of cover, and other factors.

The data revealed that the average price of most books increased in line with inflation, while some books recorded price reductions.

Books in the GKMR were slightly less available during the survey period in 2024 compared to the survey period last year. Some bookstores had, however, indicated that they would be receiving new stock soon, especially the primary level texts that were being revised. As such, the availability of books was expected to increase by the end of August, but this could also mean increased prices.

It is worth noting that consumers do have several options available to source textbooks. Outside of the traditional option of visiting the store and purchasing books, the CAC is aware of independent distributors who have established relationships with schools to supply textbooks. There are also online sources through which texts/ supplies can be sourced and parents are encouraged to explore these options.

The CAC encourages consumers to shop around and take advantage of lower priced old stock and discounts where they exist. Parents are encouraged to check with the schools to ensure the books are still relevant, especially as it relates to the correct edition of each text and in keeping with the Primary Exit Profile (PEP) curriculum. They are also advised to closely examine workbooks and student books before purchase, to prevent purchasing the incorrect book.

We hope the results of our survey will assist them in making informed purchasing decisions.
